## Policy for Awards & Prizes

Bhoj Reddy Engineering College for Women (BRECW) is committed to recognizing and encouraging academic excellence among its students. This policy establishes transparent guidelines for the award of

- 1) **Merit Awards**
- 2) **Consistent Merit Awards**
- 3) **Gold & Silver Medals**
- 4) **Felicitation of University Gold medalists**

### **Purpose**

To recognize and encourage academic excellence among students through merit awards and medals. This policy shall apply to all regular undergraduate students of BRECW enrolled in programmes affiliated to the University.

### **Objectives**

The objectives of this policy are to:

- 1 Encourage students to strive for academic excellence.
- 2 Recognize outstanding performance in university examinations.
- 3 Reward consistency in academic achievement.
- 4 Honour the departmental toppers through prestigious gold and silver medals.
- 5 Felicitate university gold medallists

## **1. Merit Awards**

### **1.1. Eligibility Criteria**

A student shall be eligible for a Merit Award if she satisfies all the following conditions:

### **1.2 Academic Performance**

The student shall secure a **minimum aggregate of 75% marks in the External Theory Examinations** of the semester.

### **1.2 Examination Status**

- 1 Only marks obtained in the **University External Theory Examinations** shall be considered.
- 2 Internal assessment marks, practical examinations, projects, seminars and laboratory examinations shall not be included.

- 3 The student shall have passed all the theory subjects of that semester in the first attempt only and supply results or RC/RV results are not considered.

### 1.3 Calculation of Merit Percentage

The Merit Percentage shall be calculated as:

#### Merit Percentage (%)

$$= (\text{Total External Theory Marks Obtained} \div \text{Total Maximum External Theory Marks}) \times 100$$

Honorarium amount for the merit awards is given according to the percentage obtained and it is as given below

### 2. Consistent Merit Award

The Consistent Excellence Award is instituted to recognize students who maintain outstanding academic performance throughout all semesters of their programme. Students receiving Merit Awards in every semester shall be eligible. The Overall Merit Percentage shall be calculated as the average of merit percentages of all semesters excluding 8<sup>th</sup> semester.

$$\text{Overall Merit Percentage} = \text{Sum of Semester Merit Percentages} \div \text{Number of Semesters}$$

### **3. Gold & Silver Medals**

Organization started honouring exceptional academic achievers of each department through Gold and Silver Medals.

Gold Medal shall be awarded to the First topper of the department and Silver Medal to the second topper of the department based on the final academic performance.

#### **3.1. Eligibility**

Separate medals shall be awarded for each department students graduating in the relevant academic year.

##### **3.1.1 Gold Medal**

Awarded to the student who secures the highest overall academic performance.

##### **3.1.2 Silver Medal**

Awarded to the student who secures second highest overall academic performance.

From the academic year 2024-25 it is decided to give a cash prize of 5,000 and 4,000 is to be given to the students who receive Gold and Silver Medals according to the institutional criteria.

### **3.2 Basis of Ranking**

Departmental ranking shall be determined based on:

1. Final CGPA awarded by the University.
2. Students must have passed all subjects required for the award of the degree in the first attempt only.
3. In case of a tie, the following order shall apply:
  - a. Higher aggregate percentage in university external examinations.
  - b. Fewer supplementary attempts.
  - c. Higher marks in core programme subjects.
  - d. Decision of the Academic Council.

### **4. Felicitation of University gold medalists**

In recognition of exceptional academic excellence, Bhoj Reddy Engineering College for Women (BRECW) shall felicitate students who secure the **Gold Medal from Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad (JNTUH)** among all affiliated colleges in their respective programmes.

The eligible student shall be awarded a **cash prize of ₹15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only)** along with a certificate of appreciation.

The objective of this award is to acknowledge outstanding academic achievement at the university level, encourage students to strive for excellence, and bring pride and recognition to the institution.

#### **Eligibility:**

1. The student must have been officially declared as a **JNTUH Gold Medal recipient** in the respective programme among all affiliated colleges.
2. The award shall be granted based on the official notification issued by JNTUH.
3. The cash prize shall be awarded once for each eligible student upon verification of the university records.

#### **Nature of Awards**

The following shall be presented to the award winners:

#### **Merit Awards**

- Cash Prize.
- Certificate of Merit.

### **Consistent Excellence Award**

- Cash Prize.
- Special Certificate of Consistent Academic Excellence.

### **Silver Jubilee Academic Medals**

- Cash prize and Gold Medal Certificate.
- Cash prize and Silver Medal Certificate.

### **University Gold medals**

- Cash prize
- Certificate of appreciation/Citation
