

We've organized a Guest Lecture on "Database and Web Programming in Python" for IV BTech ECE A, Band C on 15 November 2022.








Invitation of "Freshers Party 2022"




Circuit Design

This event tested students' knowledge across various topics in electronics and communication engineering, encouraging comprehensive learning.








