- BRECW develops confident and articulative young women into dynamic Engineers equipped with skills, knowledge, values and an attitude to contribute to the society.

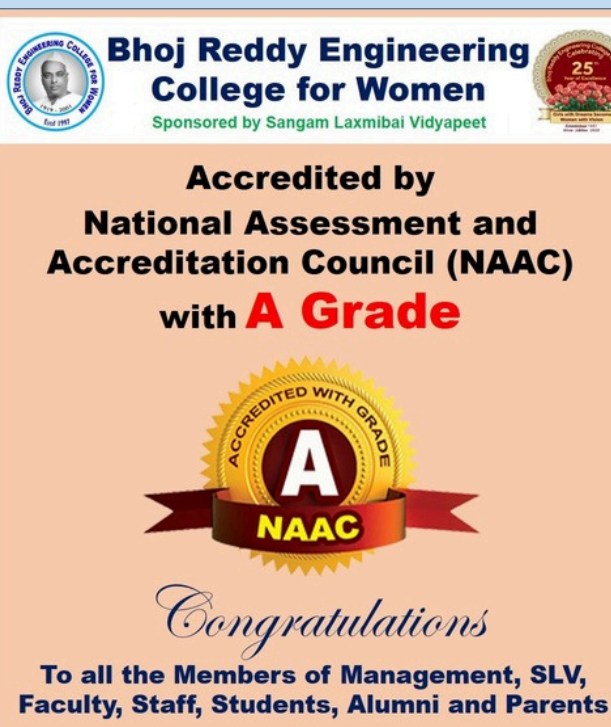
Mission:

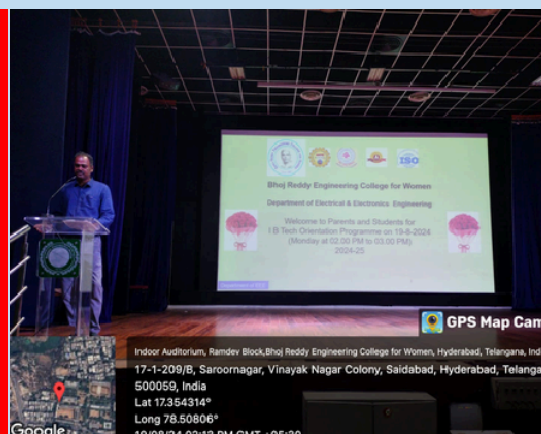

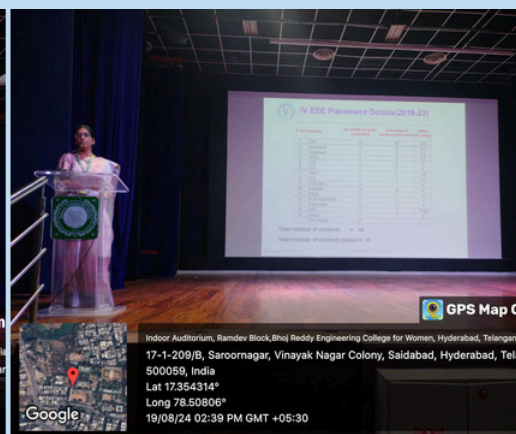

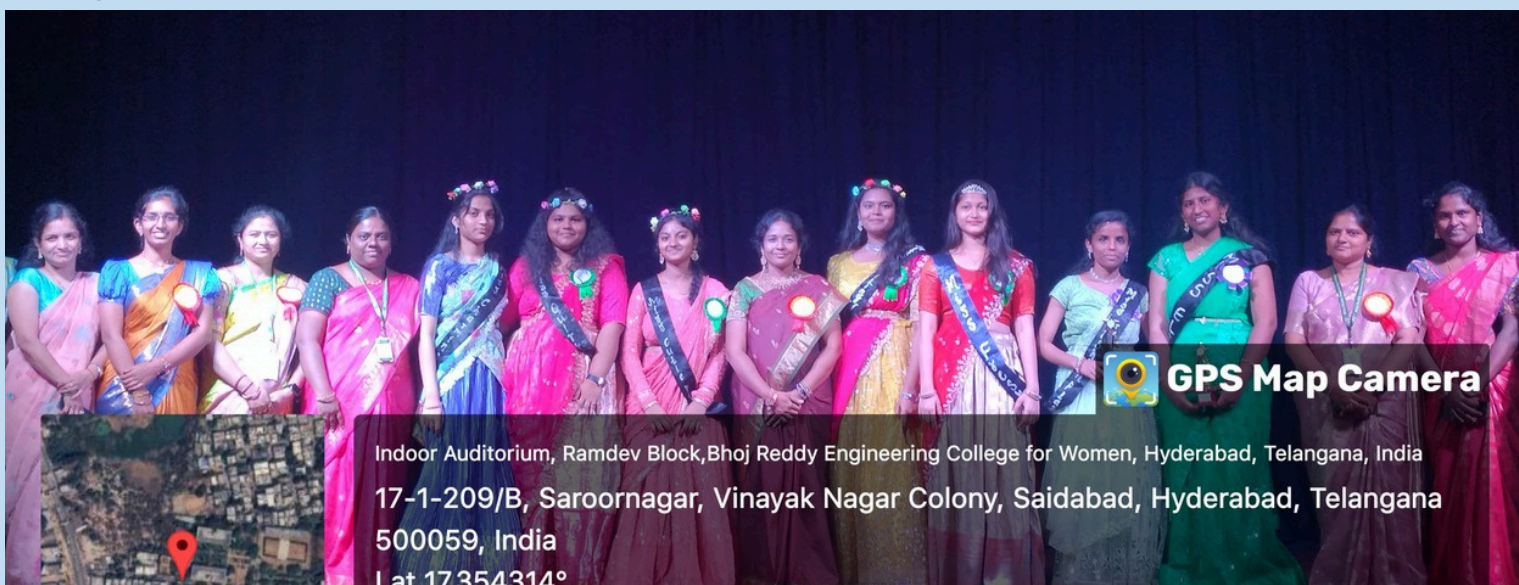


HOD's Speech

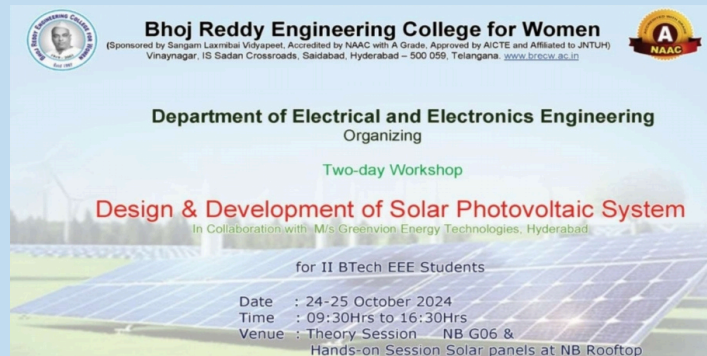

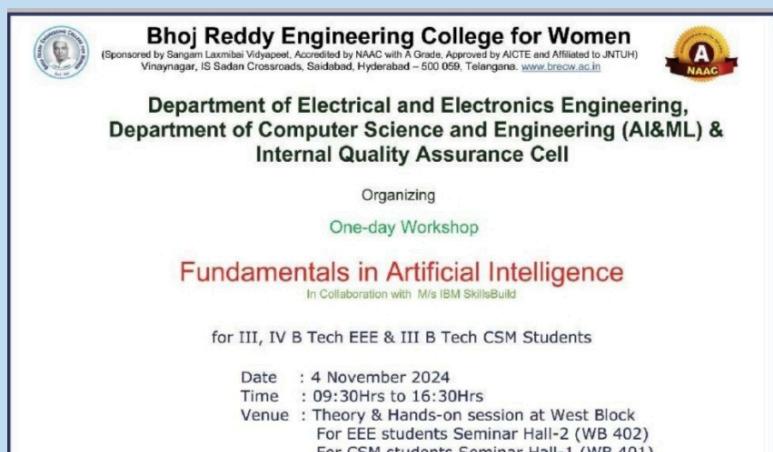

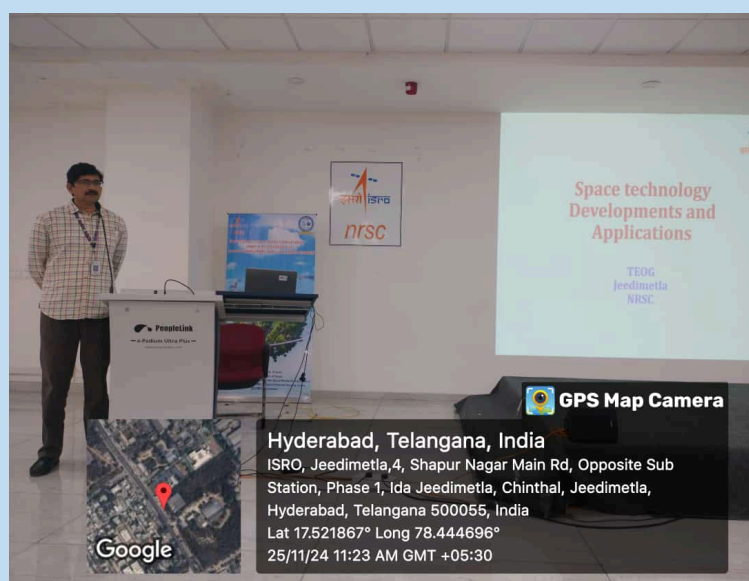
