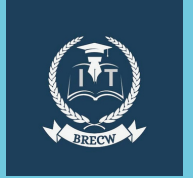

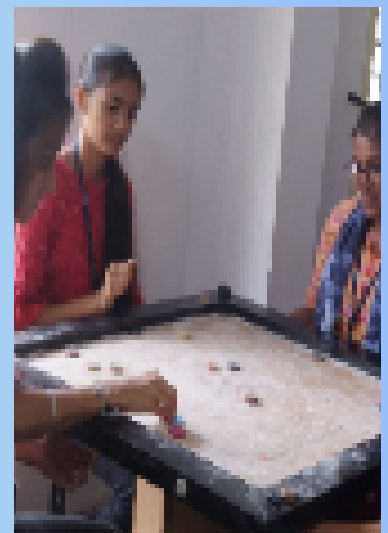

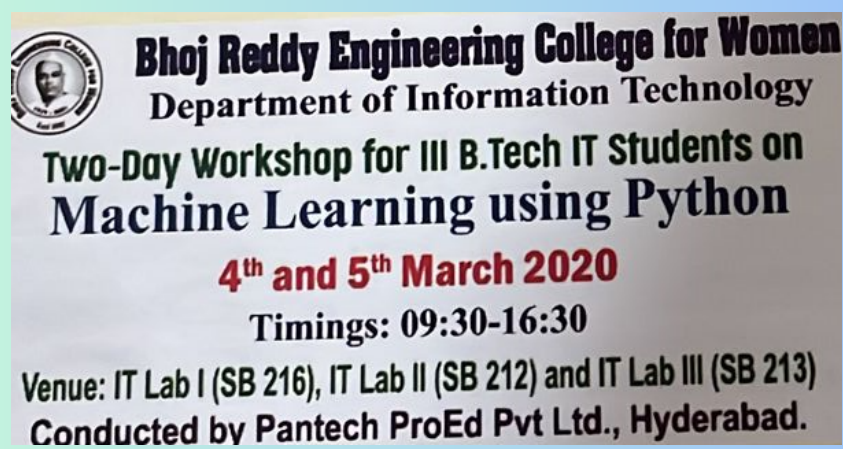


Awareness on Plastics Usage

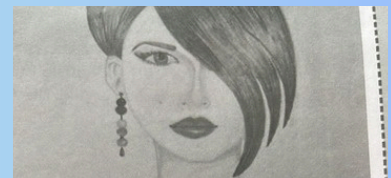
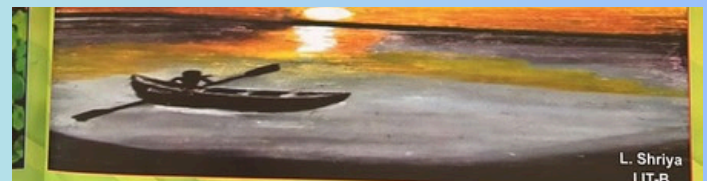

Faculty distributing the Groceries in pandemic

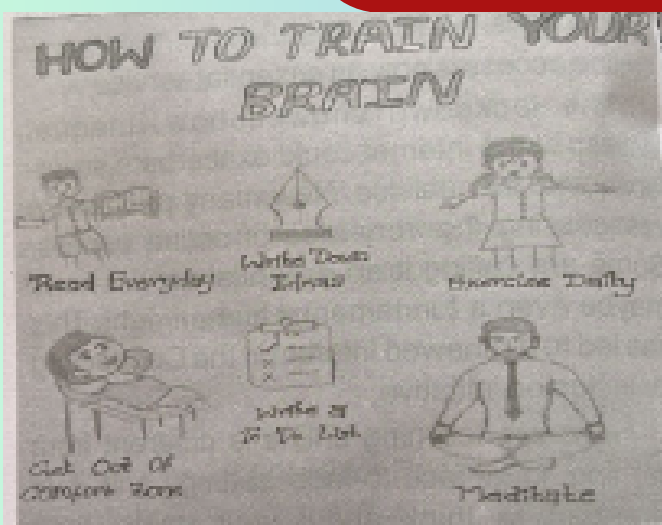

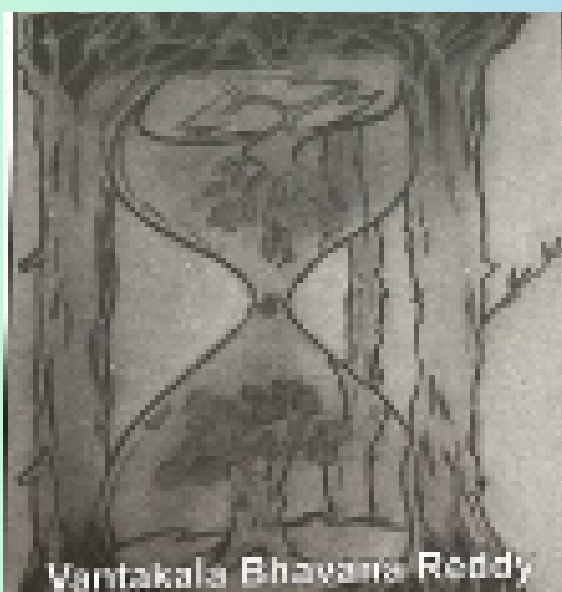




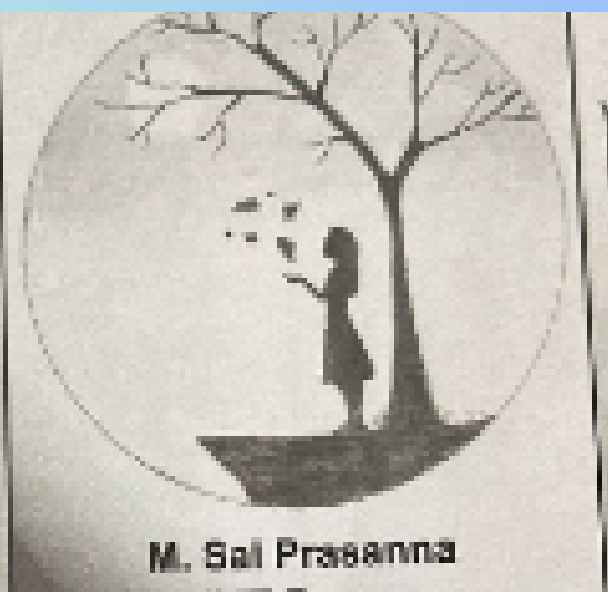

Srijan Pal Singh and Phanindra Kumar are the co-founders and the important pillars of the Kalam Bharat Project, a program established on the idea and vision of Dr. A. P. J. Abdul Kalam towards a developed India and an inclusive society.

"KALAM BHARAT" 2019, is a school adoption program for 250 schools in and around Hyderabad Rangareddy, Medchal and Sangareddy districts. This is a 15-week internship for youth and 100 of school adoption cum community service program to empower the ignited minds of the nation with the ability to dream the impossible, knowledge of technologies of tomorrow, and moral values.

The task is to take a 3-hour session every week discussing upon the student problems, and creating awareness on the importance of education, water conservation, waste management, sanitation, traffic rules, voting rights and teaching the school kids on technologies of tomorrow like Artificial Intelligence, Nanotechnology, Astrobiology etc.

The students of our college also took part in this internship. We did a great job in handling the students of Govt. schools and executed the objectives of the program successfully. It was a great platform for us to develop skills like Critical thinking, time management, teamwork, decision-making, responsibility and selflessness.

Taking the visions of Abdul Kalam forward, the program aims to build curiosity, unite the young minds of the nation and Reignite the passion to do good for the nation and the world.

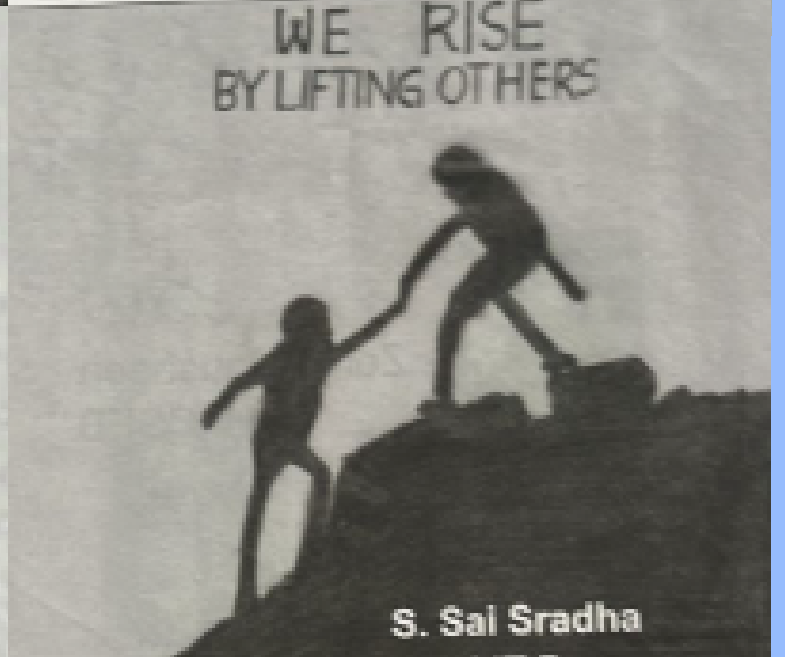
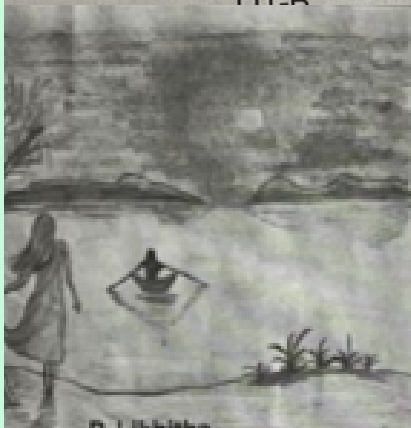
